

Bylaw to Section 24 of the Rules of Canterbury Track Cycling

SELECTIONS

(a) A panel of three (3) selectors for all events shall be appointed at the Annual Meeting. One member on the panel shall be appointed Convenor. In addition, the squad coach will be consulted prior to team selections being made.

(b) The selectors shall submit their selections to the board prior to release for approval.

(c) Any riders wishing to gain selection for Canterbury Track Teams are encouraged to have competed at a minimum of 50% of all track racing from December, with the only exception being National representatives who have National duties ie World Cups etc.

(d) Track Selection Policy

(1) **Sprints** – Unlimited entries

(2) **Individual Pursuits** – 1st and 2nd place getters at Canterbury Championships plus time qualifiers.

(3) **Kilometer / 500m TT** – 1st and 2nd place getters at Canterbury Championships plus time qualifiers.

(4) **Points Race** – First (2) placings at Canterbury Track Championships, plus others at selectors discretion

(5) **Scratch Races** – First (3) at Canterbury Track Championships, plus remainder at selectors discretion

NB Selection numbers for Individual events may alter upon a review currently being conducted by BikeNZ, thus we will have to align our numbers to BikeNZ entry numbers at a National Track Championship.

(6) **Teams Pursuit** – A squad of up to six (6) riders per team given to team/squad coaches. The final team will be decided/announced at Track Nationals based off National Championship form, based around team dynamics that will give the team its best opportunity of success. The final team will be decided by the squad coach and Canterbury Team manager, along with the

Convenor of selectors. The final team to be decided by squad coach and manager and announced in a meeting the evening before the event to each individual of the squad.

(7) **Team Sprint** – A squad of up to four (4) riders per team given to squad coaches by Canterbury Track Selectors, along with input of squad coach. The final team will be decided/announced at Track Nationals based off National Championship form, and based around team dynamics that will give the team the best opportunity of success. The final team will be decided by the squad coach and Canterbury Team manager, along with the Convenor of Selectors. The final team to be announced individually to riders the evening before at the team accommodation, in a private individual meeting where possible.

(e) Discretionary Changes to team after selections

(1) The Canterbury Track Team make up, and event selection can be changed by the Canterbury Team Manager along with the Squad Coach for the following reasons

(a) An athlete becomes ill and is unable to fulfil team selection to the expected standard

(b) The athlete is injured as the result of an accident and is unable to fulfil team selection to the expected standard

(c) An obvious loss of form and are being out performed by other team members

(d) An athlete can be replaced as a result of disciplinary action.

***** If in the event the Track Nationals are held before the Canterbury Championships, for Elite and U19 Selections in timed events, times will be considered from Southland Track Championships, Mid Season Track Championships, and any other official timed rides undertaken with a Commissaire in attendance to ratify the timing.**

With regard to scratch events, selectors will be looking at performances at Southland Track Championships, Canterbury Track Carnival and all races up to the date that Canterbury Selections have to be received from BikeNZ.

The selection criteria has been approved by the Committee members of the Canterbury Track Cycling Incorporated on the 14th day of October 2014.
